### ★ Objectives include increasing understanding of:

- \*INFANTS AT RISK OF DEVELOPING HYPOGLYCEMIA AND HYPOTHERMIA,
  - \*SIGNS OF HYPOGLYCEMIA, TREATMENT, AND REASSESSMENT
- \*THE PHYSIOLOGIC RESPONSE TO HYPOTHERMIA, ALONG WITH MECHANISMS OF HEAT LOSS AND GAIN,
  - \*SIGNS OF RESPIRATORY DISTRESS AND FAILURE; AND MANAGEMENT OF NEWBORNS IN RESPIRATORY DISTRESS,
    - \*RESPIRATORY ILLNESS AND CHALLENGES THAT PRESENT IN THE NEONATAL PERIOD
- \*THE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION TO EVALUATE FOR SHOCK, RESPIRATORY DISTRESS, AND SEPSIS,
  - \*CAUSES AND MANAGEMENT OF THE 3 MAIN TYPES OF SHOCK SEEN IN THE NEWBORN,
    - \*CLINICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF ABC RESULTS, AND APPROPRIATE INTERVENTIONS,
  - \*STRATEGIES FOR SUPPORTING THE FAMILIES OF NEWBORNS REQUIRING TRANSPORT.
