★ Objectives include increasing understanding of:

- *INFANTS AT RISK OF DEVELOPING HYPOGLYCEMIA AND HYPOTHERMIA,
 - *SIGNS OF HYPOGLYCEMIA, TREATMENT, AND REASSESSMENT
- *THE PHYSIOLOGIC RESPONSE TO HYPOTHERMIA, ALONG WITH MECHANISMS OF HEAT LOSS AND GAIN,
- *SIGNS OF RESPIRATORY DISTRESS AND FAILURE; AND MANAGEMENT OF NEWBORNS IN RESPIRATORY DISTRESS,
 - *RESPIRATORY ILLNESS AND CHALLENGES THAT PRESENT IN THE NEONATAL PERIOD
- *THE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION TO EVALUATE FOR SHOCK, RESPIRATORY DISTRESS, AND SEPSIS,
 - *CAUSES AND MANAGEMENT OF THE 3 MAIN TYPES OF SHOCK SEEN IN THE NEWBORN,
 - *CLINICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF ABC RESULTS, AND APPROPRIATE INTERVENTIONS,
 - *STRATEGIES FOR SUPPORTING THE FAMILIES OF NEWBORNS REQUIRING TRANSPORT.
